Airport Managers Report: Earle Bares

- * Jet tank did not meet code or EPA requirements and cost \$6,000/\$2,000 for JETA low lead. We are \$8,100 over budget.
- * JETA fuel sales 10,000 gal. since May 1st. Fuel costs continue to climb
- * All hanger space is rented
- * We are losing fuel sales to Muskegon (down 5%). If and where they raise their price business will come back to Grand Haven airport.
- * We have 59 aircraft on the field.
- * At long last hanger roof request for bid being completed

Administrative Liaison Report: Tom Manderscheid

- * Accounts Receivables 30-60-90 days as of October 25, 2021 is \$4,271.50 in the arrears.
- * The Airport fund cash balance as of October 16, 2021, is \$88,614.23
- * There is \$30,000 in crack sealing budget
- * Overall budget looks good with \$177,090 less 5%.
- * The City of Grand Haven has applied for additional Airport funding of \$13,000 from MDOT AERO and is awaiting an answer.
- * The permanent painting and the runway shoulders on runway 9/27 has been completed
- * Final payment to the Michigan Pavement Contractors will be requested by the City to MDOT Aero the week of 10-18-2021
- * The General session of the MAP Meeting originally scheduled for October 20th was rescheduled for Wednesday, October 27, 2021 at 10:00 am. The 3GM MAP Meeting originally scheduled for November 4 at 10:00am has been moved back to Wednesday, November 3rd at 10:30-11:45am. The Zoom meeting will be held at City Hall.
- * A procurement process will begin to select an Airport Consultant that best suits the Airport needs, a process that occurs every three years. Last time this process has been completed was 2016. We will have to identify all our projects over the next 5 years before we can spend any Grand funds and this will be part of our procurement process which will come up in November.
- * Tom presented Earle Bares with his 5 year work anniversary pin.
