Superintendent Vredeveld updates the board on the operations of the plant. Plant maintained compliance for ammonia discharge limits during July, a great sign that the plant can promote Nitrification to achieve exceptional ammonia discharge concentrations that far exceed the restricted limits the plant faces in July and August. Vredeveld provided a recap on the July WWTP open house event referred to as Party in the Park. In addition, updates were given on various projects around the facility.

A. Biosolids Drying Feasibility Study by Prein & Newhof

Nate Ver Heul of Prein & Newhof presents on the final report on the study they performed on drying biosolids technologies at the WWTP facility. This study was performed to help provide the Sewer Authority Board with options when faced with a decision to update plant operations when plant staff's option in disposals outlets changes in regards to biosolids. Discussion is had following the report, with many board members acknowledging that the concerns about the changing environment surrounding land application.
